The **World Scout Moot** is a gathering of older Scouts, mainly Rover Scouts, ages 18–26 (although there was no upper age limit for the earlier Moots) from all over the

world. Moots are held every four years and are organized by the World Organization of the Scout Movement.

NYLT: National Youth Leadership Training

The NYLT course simulates a month in the life of a unit. It is a six-day course, usually held at Lost Valley. It reinforces and expands upon Be-Know-Do leadership.

As a leader you will utilize the Teaching EDGE(TM) for the Scouts to learn a number of leadership skills and concepts. You will learn about the stages of team development and how to match the most appropriate leadership style with the developmental stage of the individual or team.

Campmaster Corps

Summer Camp Staff

Lost Valley's summer camp staff members are at least 15 years of age, some areas require older staff. There is also a Counselor in Training (C.I.T.) position for youth who are 14 years old.



Many Program Areas require staff to be over 18 and many Program Area Directors must be over 18 or over 21. Schoepe Scout Reservation is flexible in working around school, work, Scouting, and other personal commitments.

European Camp Staff Program

The **European Camp Staff program** is operated by the European Region of the World Organization of the Scout Movement. Members of the Boy Scouts of America, ages 18 through 30, are given opportunity to serve as coun-



sultors in European Region Scout camps and training centers. Room and board are provided in camp in addition to accident and illness insurance. The counselor pays for personal roundtrip air transportation. Upon completion of the job assignment, BSA will reimburse the participant a portion of his travel expenses.



BSA Contingent Program

As a member of the World Organization of the Scout Movement, the Boy Scouts of America gets invited to many different international/national events in different countries every year. This is a great opportunity for the BSA to connect with the world through interaction with local Scouts and Scout leaders at those special events.

Depending on the locations, time, availability of Direct Service units, attendees, and budgets, a national contingent may be formed for these international events. BSA Scouts and Scout leaders are selected from all over the country, not just from one troop/crew in the same council.

In order to qualify for a BSA contingent, Scouts and Scout leaders must be nominated to the International Department by their council international representative and approved by their council Scout executive.
