Although the foundation is pleased to accept gifts of any size, membership in the Order of the Condor is conferred upon those who provide total support of US\$1,000 or more.



Direct Service BSA

Direct Service is administered by the International Department of the BSA. The purpose of Direct Service is to provide Scouting to US citizens and their dependents living in countries outside of the jurisdiction of the Transatlantic Council, serving countries in Europe, and the Far East Council, which serves countries in the Far East.

Approximately 3500 Scouts and Scouters in 40 countries are in units registered through Direct Service.
