



INTERNATIONAL RECOGNITIONS

There are several emblems and awards that recognize a Scout's participation and membership in the World Brotherhood of Scouting.

The **World Crest** is the emblem of the World Organization of the Scout Movement. It is worn centered above the left pocket



The **World Conservation Award** provides the opportunity for youth to think globally about the issues of conservation and environmental preservation.

This award can be earned by Cubs, Scouts and Venturers. Each level has its own requirements.



The **International Spirit Award** an award available to both adults and youth. The aims of this award are to broaden the recipients' knowledge of International Scouting and expose them to the cultures of other countries.

To be eligible to wear an **interpreter strip**. A Scout or Scouter must be able to carry on a conversation in a foreign language or in sign language, write a letter in the foreign language (not required for signing), and translate orally and in writing from one language to another.



The **International Scouter's Award** encourages Scouters to broaden their involvement in Scouting by participating in international activities and recognizes them for their contributions to World Scouting.
