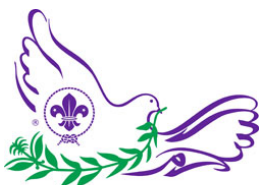




Are You A Messenger of Peace?



Messengers of Peace

Messengers of Peace (MOP) is a global initiative designed to inspire millions of young men and women around the globe to work toward peace. Using social media, Scouts and Guides from around the world share what they've done and inspire their fellow Scouts to undertake similar efforts in their own communities.

Earn the Award!

Scouts who complete Messenger of Peace projects will be eligible for a special recognition: a ring patch that goes around the World Crest. The patch symbolizes their participation in an ever-widening circle of Scouts who are not just visualizing world peace but are helping to make it a reality.



How to Earn the MOP Award

1. Participate in a Messenger of Peace Project

A Messenger of Peace is any Scouting service project that promotes peace. This can be a project that promotes peace through equality, a project that supports a community, a project promoting peace through environmental stewardship.

As part of the process of performing service, a designated person from the unit that organized the project should report the service hours to the unit's **Journey to Excellence (JTE)** account on scouting.org. When the project is reported to JTE, designate the project as a MOP project.

2. Post the Project to the Messengers of Peace Website

Someone in the unit is designated to report the project to the MOP website, scout.org.

To purchase the patches print out the project certificate from the JTE website and present it to the Scout Shop
