Scouting was officially founded in Argentina in 1912, shortly after the publication of "Scouting For Boys" in Spanish. It was granted a National Charter in 1917, and was among the charter members of the World Organization of the Scout Movement. Scouts de Argentina has over 42,000 members.

In Argentina it is customary to celebrate the Scout Good Turn Day every year on September 5th,
