2010 15th Nippon Jamboree. Ken Takemura from Troop 578 discussed his troop's plans for attending this event scheduled for Aug. 1-9. There will be 35 Scouts, four to six leaders and 50 to 60 parents and siblings. Some will leave on July 21 and the others on July 23. Since it is being done differently this year (more like World Jamboree), the troop is concerned about logistics for equipment since there is a limitation on luggage.
